



HOMEWORK POLICY

The school homework policy will apply to all classes.

Pupils should do homework regularly for the following reasons.

Homework:-

1. Encourages pupils to organise themselves and disciplines them to develop and maintain a regular work schedule in an independent manner.
2. Helps pupils learn and practise skills taught in class.
3. Allows pupils to discover whether they have understood a topic.
4. Allows further development of class work.
5. Gives parents a further awareness of their children's education.
6. Gives teachers the awareness of the ability of the pupils in their class and adopt their teaching method accordingly

The time allocated for homework is as follows:-

AS/A2	180 mins

Pupils will be given adequate time to complete tasks to a high standard.

The responsibility for ensuring that homework is regularly set and marked, according to the homework timetable, lies with the Class Teacher.

The responsibility for supervising homework lies with the parents.

The responsibility for monitoring homework lies with the Class Teacher and the parents.

Homework will take a variety of forms including:-

Reading, Writing, Learning, Re-inforcing, Researching and Problem solving

To encourage pupils to make satisfactory efforts with their homework, good work will be rewarded and sanctions will be applied to those who make little or no effort.
