



HOMEWORK POLICY

The school homework policy will apply to all classes.

Pupils are encouraged do homework regularly for the following reasons.

- ✓ Encourages pupils to organise themselves and disciplines them to develop and maintain a regular work schedule in an independent manner.
- ✓ Helps pupils learn and practise skills taught in class.
- ✓ Allows pupils to discover whether they have understood a topic.
- ✓ Allows further development of class work.
- ✓ Gives parents a further awareness of their children's education.
- ✓ Gives teachers the awareness of the ability of the pupils in their class and adopt their teaching method accordingly

Amount of homework

As they move through school, we increase the amount of homework that we give pupils.

Year Groups	Minimum Time Per Week
Y1	30 mins
Y2	30 mins
Y3	40 mins
Y4	40 mins
Y5	60 mins
Y6	60 mins
Y7	60 mins
GCSE	90 mins

Homework is an important part of the curriculum for pupils, and in line with National Curriculum guidance we provide regular homework for pupils in all year groups.

Homework will be uploaded once a week and available via the school website www.peiyingschool.org.

How can parents help?

We recognise the importance that parents and carers play in children's learning and to enjoy the learning experience with their children. The school expects parents/carers to support their learning experience through supervising homework to ensure assignments are completed on time and to the best of their ability.

Parents can support learning by taking an interest in the topics studied and supporting pupils in managing their time in order to complete the work set by the given deadline.
